(Eagles Nest)

Welcome to “Eagles Nest”. I hope your stay is enjoyable. Recognizing that this is most likely your first visit to “Eagles Nest”, following are a few tips on how to find or operate various features in the house:

1. The house keys you have been issued operate the front door entrance into the mud room and the double door access into the entry hall. They also operate the rear door access to the mud room and the door to the laundry room.
2. Driveway snow removal is accomplished when snow depth is 6 inches or greater. B & B Bobcat Services (Brian Bardsley), (775) 450-9157, provides this service. Please note that before the Bonnie Ct. Street has been plowed, Brian is often unable to reach the driveway with his Bobcat.
3. The driveway is lit by floodlights on three poles which line the driveway. Switches in the entry hall and next to the living room sliding glass door operate the floodlights. These switches are identified as “driveway lights”.
4. Please leave skis and snowboards in the entry hall or in the small storage room off the entry hall.
5. The house phone number is (775) 588-2075. You can receive calls, make local calls and dial 911. You are unable to make long distance calls from this phone.
6. The house is equipped with wireless, hi-speed internet.
7. Snow shovels are located in the entrance mud room and outside the dining room sliding glass door. Several windshield scrapers are also in the entrance mud room.
8. The house has 8 temperature zones, each controlled by a thermostat. The temperature elements in the first floor (entry hall, bedroom suite and garage) are embedded in the cement floor. Several space heaters are stored in the entry hall closet.

9. The house has a central vacuum system. The vacuum attachments are located in the closet at the base of the stairway leading to the loft bedroom.
10. The fireplace has a gas starter. The valve key is on the right side of the fireplace. The lighter is typically on the fireplace mantle. Be sure the chimney vent is open.
11. The spa outside the main floor master bedroom is ready for use. The spa temperature is kept at approximately 100 degrees F.
12. The loft bedroom has a sloping ceiling. Please watch your head when navigating this bedroom. Those ceiling beams are solid.
13. The main floor master bedroom has a steam shower. To operate, turn the timer switch outside the shower to the desired length of time. The steam will turn off automatically.
14. The garbage compactor is opened by a foot pedal. Do not try and pry open from the top.
15. BEARS. During 2006, bears broke into the house on two occasions. Both occasions were due to human error. The first instance occurred when the front door was locked but still ajar and the bear was able to push open the door and enter the house. The second instance occurred when a kitchen window was left open. Even though it was covered by a screen, a bear was able to smell food in the kitchen and ripped the screen off and climbed through the kitchen window. Please keep all windows and doors at ground and deck level closed and locked, particularly when you leave the house.
